 - CHAMOMILE DYER'S CHAMOMILE; PRETTY YELLOW FLOWERS
 - MINT CONTAIN IN POTS; USE FOR TEA
 - OREGANO ZA'ATAR VARIETY USED IN MEDITERRANEAN COOKING
 - MARJORAM ITALIAN SEASONING; RELATED TO OREGANO
 - LOVAGE CELERY FLAVOR FOR SOUPS
- LEMON SAVORY LEMON FLAVOR; GOOD FOR MARINADES
 - LEMONGRASS FOR THAI RECIPES; BRING INDOORS IN THE WINTER





COMPANION PLANTS

PLANTING THESE PLANTS CLOSE TO EACH OTHER WILL INCREASE YIELDS AND DECREASE INSECT PRESSURE. SOME COMPANION PLANTS HELP SUPPORT EACH OTHER, LITERALLYI TRY GROWING POLE BEAMS NEXT TO SWEET CORN AND LETTING THE BEAMS USE THE CORN STALK AS A TRELLIS.

BENEFICIAL CRITTER PLANTS

BENEFICIAL INSECTS AND OTHER ANIMALS EAT BAD BUGS, POLLINATE FLOWERS AND VEGETABLES, AND MAKE THE GARDEN A BETTER PLACE. BENEFICIALS CAN BE ANYTHING FROM BIRDS TO BEES TO BUTTERFLIES. THEY WILL VISIT WHATEVER IS BLOOMING, BUT THESE ARE SOME FAVORITES:

TOMATOES AND BASIL NASTURTIUMS AND SQUASH/CUCUMBER/ZUCCHINI DILL AND ANNUAL FLOWERS/VEGETABLES CHAMOMILE AND MARIGOLDS ARE ALSO GOOD FOR PLANTING AROUND VEGGIES AS THEIR STRONG SMELL REPELS PESTS

DILL AND FENNEL ZUCCHINI/CUCUMBER/SQUASH AGASTACHE AND SALVIA SWAMP SUNFLOWER



CONTAINER COMBINATIONS

THE GENERAL FORMULA FOR CONTAINERS IS TO HAVE A THRILLER (FOCAL FLOWER), A FILLER, AND A SPILLER (SOMETHING TO FALL OVER THE SIDES). HERE ARE SOME OF THE PLANTS WE HAVE AVAILABLE, DIVIDED INTO THESE CATEGORIES.

ALOE VERA

HEAL THE BURNI IF YOU CAN REMEMBER THE LAST TIME YOU WATERED YOUR ALOE, DON'T WATER YET.


